Objective:

The aim is to provide a broad overview of the interaction between host and microbes and give the participants insight in how pathogens evolve different strategies to evade the immune response. The course is intended to provide information about methods and strategies used for studying these interactions. The aim is also to provide a platform for networking between participants in an informal atmosphere.

Attendance at seminars is mandatory. In addition, oral presentations and written summary of the individual research projects and iRAT (individual readiness assurance tests) after TBL (team based learning) will be part of the overall examination.
