The **7th National Infection Biology Meeting** will gather experimental researchers, physicians and epidemiologists interested in molecular and clinical microbiology, immunology and host-pathogen interactions. The programme includes keynote talks by invited speakers, talks selected from submitted abstracts and a poster session. The meeting will start at noon Tuesday and close at 4 pm Wednesday, 17-18 October.

NIB 2017 will be held at the Conference Centre Djurönäset in the archipelago of Stockholm and is co-organised by the National Network for Infection Biology (NIB), The Laboratory for Molecular Infection Medicine Sweden (MIMS), and the National Doctoral Programme in Infections and Antibiotics (NDPIA).
